## Get college credit at Lakeland High School!

IPFW is looking for able students like you who are interested in earning dual college credit while taking courses in high school. Seniors, juniors, and qualified sophomores and freshman are eligible to get a head start on college course work.

**Concurrent Enrollment** is the right choice for you to:

- Earn college credit while you earn high school credit—without leaving your school
- Save money on college tuition (pay about 60-90 percent less than on-campus tuition)
- Earn credits toward your Indiana Academic Honors diploma
- Finish college faster



Your high school is participating in the IPFW Collegiate Connection school-based program (SBP). That means that you have the option of taking courses taught in your school for both high school and college credit. These courses are taught by IPFW-certified high school teachers.



### Admission Requirements:

- Have a GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)—8.0 (on a 12.0 scale)
- Rank in the top half of your high school class
- Have passed end-of-course exams in English and algebra
- Students under the age of 18 should also have the approval of a parent/guardian.

**Financial Assistance:** IPFW will cover the tuition for students who qualify for the free or reduced textbook/lunch program and meet the admission requirements. If an additional textbook or materials are required, the student is responsible for those expenses.

**Transfer Options:** SBP students earn college credit for these courses, and they can request an official IPFW transcript be submitted to the college of their choice. Most IPFW courses are transferable to other public institutions in Indiana, and many private or out-of-state colleges also accept transfer credit. Students should always check with their potential college advisor on specific degree requirements and transfer questions.
